To Mr. Fox,
I send salu-
tations to you. I heard
on the 20th of March his
force attacked Wairoa
between that night and
the morning of the 21st
the attack was made and
it lasted until daylight.
Eighteen were killed. Katarua
was the Chief who was killed.
Those whose lives were spared
belonging to the Kootis own party
including the hauhaus of
this place were one hundred
and three, men women and
children, there they are.
Wirimu Kingi Te Apaapa
is the Chief of these spared.
Kereopa ran away and
was not caught because
these people did not know
him

him. Pi Kooti was
in another pa which
was attacked by Rapata
but that man was not
killed.

Now a friend hearken
to my proposal about the
one hundred and three,
let them be left with me
let those who are dead
be sufficient for you and
your Buecote tribes, let me
have the living. However,
this can be arranged
when we have an
interview.
