After studying the Court Order for the above partition I thought I must write before authorizing the surveyor to undertake the survey. It would appear that both 19A1 and 19A2A will in the near future be subject to a status declaration and will come under the Land Transfer Act. A survey will be necessary before this can be accomplished. necessary before this can be accomplished.

On 28 June 1967 I suggested to you that the three blocks be surveyed together and the charges be apportioned equally to the three blocks. The estimated cost of the whole survey was \$228.40; however, if the blocks were each surveyed separately it was estimated they would each cost \$182. Since my memorandum the Maori Affairs Amendment Act 1967 has been passed and, as stated above, a survey will be required because of this in the near future.

I have discussed this with the Land Utilization Officer, Maori Affairs, and he is prepared to undertake the survey. I would suggest that his staff should do the survey and the sum of \$182 would be obtained from the owners of 19A2B and the remaining \$46 could be charged against the titles of 19A1 and 19A2A.

To date, to my knowledge, Mr. N.D.R. Russell, Registered Surveyor, has not been involved in this partition. No plans have been prepared and the survey estimate supplied was calculated in this office.

I realize there may be pressing and cogent reasons why 19A2B should be surveyed on its own and have only suggested the above course to try and save added survey costs to the adjoining
