Re your memorandum of 13 September 1967 I return herewith, unamended, the 6 Court order diagrams. No action was taken since, by Gazette 1953 page 88, the N.Z. Geographic Board ruled that the spelling "Waiotahi" was to be adopted for the locality, river, parish, etc., instead of the spelling with an "e". I would say that Section 16 of the N.Z. Geographic Board Act 1946 is virtually a directive to your Court and Department to alter your records to "Waiotahi" as from 1953.
