them, but I do not intend to appear for them because our claims, that of Whakatohea and Aitamamahaki have over lapped and in the settlement of hitherto on the Turanga side we have taken the Whakatohea under the custain of "aroha" and I prefer to have this to be dealt with in the same way by the Whakatohea? i.e I hope they will put in some of our (maraes) by way of aroha.

Court adjourned to 10a.m. on Saturday.



At this stage (of these 3) this land was claimed by conquest from Whakatane who were living at the time with Te Uruariki and both were owners of the land. Uruariki was not a tribe but an individual. He came originally from land which is outside this block.

Killed because of the murder of my ancestor, they were driven They murdered Uru Ariki. The Whakatane were killed and driven off by the 3 children of Uru Ariki. Never heard that Reremoko drove them away. It was them that we made the entire conquest of this land. Don't know the origin of the Whakatane or where they came from. They were a very ancient people. I say positively that our other portion of the Whakatohe occupied the land we have indicated by our pencil line on this map. No canoes were ever built on this land by any other hapu but ours. nor did they occupy any houses or lived there. We had a burial place on the other side of the river, but don't know of any such place belonging to Ngati Ruamoko. They never had such a place. Oturoro was one of the pas (No 11) of our ancestors near the river. Uenuku (No 12) was another. Pawanui (No 13)was another fortified pa. Otukeka (No 14) was another. I know in the last named formerly. Raipawa (No 15) was another. The remains of these pas are still to be seen, but there were other sites of which have been obliterated by flood and winds. Matawhero (No 16) was a cultivation near the confiscated line. The stumps are to be seen (of the clearing), Kokopu (No 17) is a place I occupied and have had fruit trees planted there. Mohunuhuno (No 18) was a fern-root station. A stream of called Ohiritoa (No 19) was a place for eel fishing. Mangapumarumaru (No 20) was another such place. from the first. He was born just outside the confiscated line. He lived on the land with the Whakatane. They occupied it together. Nihokai was his birth place and it is now our occupation. He occupies both in the neighbourhood of his birth-place. I own this part that we claim as it was all one block then. After Whakatane were driven off, our ancestor occupied the land and maintained it and kept off all intruders. Raipawa I have pointed out (No 15) also Waimanu (No23). The boundaries (external) I have given were pointed out to me by my ancestor. I know them to be correct. Don't know the origin of the line forming one of my external boundaries. But I know that it is the line pointed out by my ancestors.

The pas I have attended to are fortified places and cultivations also of my ancestors. I was in occupation of different parts of this block before the fight with the Europeans took place and when that took place I made my retreat and was made to live on the land for some time in different localities. The remains of old maori forts (carved) can now be seen. TelKapare was mother of Te Uru Ariki my ancestor. Tararehe was father of TelKapare. Can't say who the owners of the land were before time of my ancestors. But I know that from time of latter, it was in their occupation, and has been in ours up to present. I am certain that there was no conquest of it by Turanga tribes. The one being the one made by our ancestor. Omapora stream shown on plan. I know a native name Pawhero and that he was a Whakatane. The Omapora stream I have already pointed out from its mouth to its source. I am not aware that, Pawhero was killed by Pakeraia and Tahu on that stream. Am not aware that, that was the cause of the fight between Ramoko and Whakatane.

Hepiripiri (No 26) is where the fight took place with Whakatane and they were driven off. It is an open piece of ground and was a cultivation. It was the first fight that ultimately led to

the Whakatane being driven off. Don't know Tauahoura (a person). Am not aware that he placed in charge of district after it was taken and for the purpose of keeping out intruders. I know Rangiwhawhata. He was a Rangitane. Am not aware that he was placed at a pa called Maraetahanui outside this block for the purpose of keeping off intruders.

Tutamoe pa outside this block I don't know though the land. Not aware of any fights by Takutokopiha, Noa, Taukuru.. This stream is in Tahora (points it out). I am not aware that Kaka was taken captive as an infant and bought away on a basket. The name of that ridge (points it out) is Pukeroa I was in occupation as a kainga, I can point out on the spot the remains of the pas that I have mentioned.

Te Assessor

The Whakatane first occupied this land. At the time they were occupying this land Te Uru Ariki was a member of the Ngati Ira hapu. When Whakatane were driven off the land fell into hands of Kotikoti and his descendants. A portion of this block was confiscated by Government but afterwards a part was awarded to Ngati Ira. If I had been a neutral, my original claim would have been so good as to have attached my name to a place in the block so given.

To Judge

I said we had 5 fortified pas. We erected them against the attacks of the Urewera, Ngati Kahungunu were also our enemies. Ngaitanga Mahaki were also. So were the Whanau Akai, Ngapuhi, Ngati Porou. The Ngapuhi made a paid as far as this place. Others I mean were possible enemies. The Urewera actually came twice. Ngati Kahungunu, Ngaitanga Mahaki actually came, Whanau Akai did not come, nor did Ngati Porou.

Uru Ariki was murdered on the occasion of his going to take possession of this land.

I know the pencil line that indicates one of your boundary. It commences at Te Moenui, thence to Te Patao, thence to Tutaitoko on confiscated line. I know that my ancestor had a pa a little distance from Te Tahora. I know of a "totara" tree that was made into a canoe by Te Hihi and or members of Ngati Ira hapu on this block. I know that my ancestor had a fishing station before Tahora and Maraetai on the Waioeka Stream. On the upper part of block (at No25) my ancestors had a field for digging fern-root. They had a plantation at Kokopu (No17) which has been in our use also. They and we had a plantation in the immediate neighbourhood of Maraetai. The last battle that was fought was at mouth of Tahora stream when the land was taken by us and held possession of. Hepiripiri was the first place of fight. The fight was against Whakatane who were beaten. 2rd fight was outside this block. 3rd ditto. Then a complete of the country was made by our ancestors and there was no more fighting. The fights outside this block were Aririki (between Waioiki and Waiweka) and Otane, between Waioeka and Waiotahi). These fights were against Whakatane. were destroyed, but there were some survivors. Don't know where latter went. No attach has been made to dilodge us from this land ever since. We had the pas mentioned by the proceeding witness. They were built protection in the event of

any attack, but none was made. The attacks said to be made by previous witness were made previously - i.e. return to the last battle I have mentioned at Tahora.

They arrived simultaneously and took up different parts of the land. Formerly this land extended beyond the confiscated line and the occupants were Whakatane, who were a numerous people and were known by the name of Ngati Ira. I know the pencil line on map and it was the one laid down by my ancestors Kotikoti, Kaiwhanaunga Manutahi.

The pencil line was the boundary between Ngatingahere and my people. It was laid down by both sides. It was the first divisional line first referred to. The Whakatane were the sole occupiers of this land both before and after the conquest. Don't know of any fights that took place near Ngataierua, under the leadership of the children/people of Ngaruamoko. Don't know that Pawhero was killed near Pa Don't know that Whakatane was killed by Ngaruamoko's children. I don't that Ruamoko was beaten in 1st engagement. Can't point out Kairakau on plan but could go to it on the land. We had a station along the ridge for the purpose of killing birds and rats.
