*Gamaru No 4<sup>A</sup>*, acquired an estate of inheritance in fee-simple *and which said order has been affirmed on rehearing.*

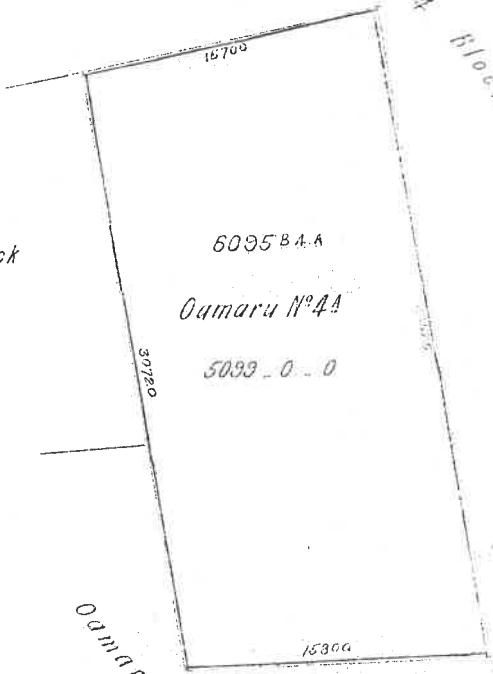
