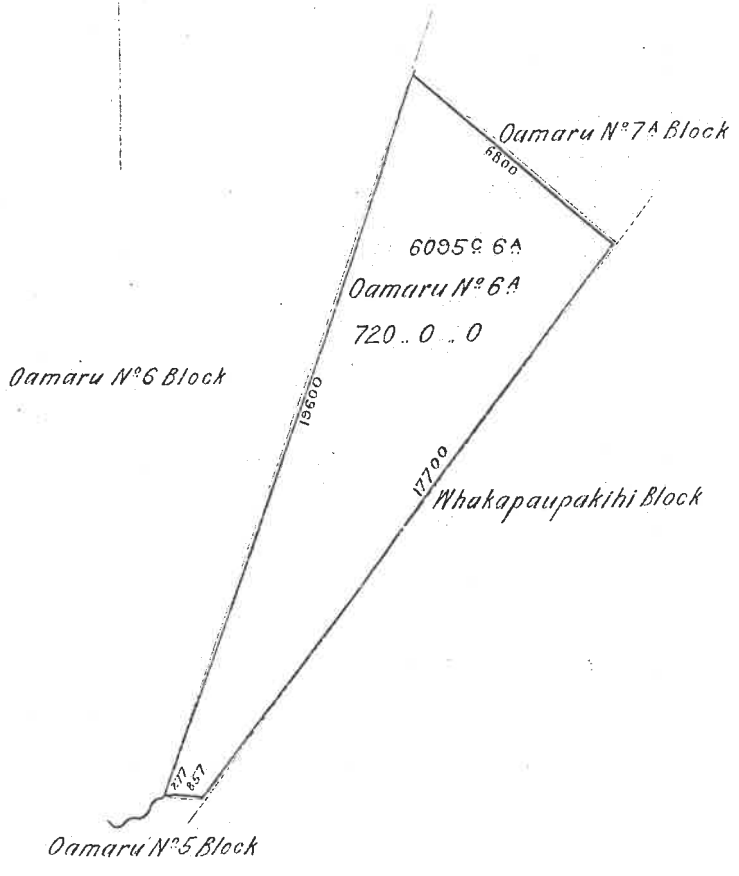
Gamamu No 6^A, acquired an estate of inheritance in fee-simple and which said order has been affirmed on rehearing.
