Terms of Lease made the 18th day of July 1962 between Te Uira te Paeata (Lessor) and James Dunlop:-

- 1. Land: Part Waiotahi 19A1 containing approximately five acres but not including the Lesson's house and two acres surrounding the same.
- 2. Rent: £3 per acre per amum payable half yearly in advance.
- 3. Term: 11 years from 1st July 1962.
- 4. The lessee will pay all rates.
- 5. The Lessee will keep down all Noxious Weeds and will keep all fences and other improvements in good repair and condition.
- 6. The Leases will each year topdress the said land with at least 2 cwt per acre of phosphatic manure.
- 7. In the event of the Lessee making default for 30 days in performance of any clause herein, the Lessor shall be entitled to cancel this Agreement.
- 8. The Lessee shall erect a boundary fence between the above land and Waiotahi 19A2B, and shall be entitled to the first two years of the term rent free.
