Re: Allotments 303 and 347 Parish of Waiotahi

Further to my letter of 1 November, the Opotiki County Council has now advised that rates on allotment 303 for the year ended 31 March 1963 were paid by Ranui Properties. The current year's rates on allotment 347 have been paid by a Mr W.J. Paul. No arrears of rates are owing on either property.

It appears likely that both these blocks are occupied and being used by the persons paying the rates and, therefore, you should make some investigations to see whether the present occupiers should obtain proper leases and pay rent.
