Friend, salutations to you.
Thus is our application of your to you, the
father of the two peoples living at Nekeawoo.
We wish to have the Block opened
called Camarii No 1 released, and all the
pieces cut of from it. The reason for this
application is that in our opinion the judg-
ment of Judge Wilson was not correct as
to the claims to that Block, considering the
important evidence given in our case.
If you consent to our prayer, do you send
a different Judge, as we do not in any
way approve of the ministry held on
our block by Judge Wilson. No you, the
Chief Judge carefully consider this, that
Judge Wilson should not be sent here to
adjudicate upon our block. Judge Wilson has
many influential friends among the heppus of the
Mushkatohea. Tanka will send you a statement as
to why we object to the judgement of Judge Wilson.
This is all. From the two heppus, Ngatipatu
and Ngatirekantihi. The applicants are -
