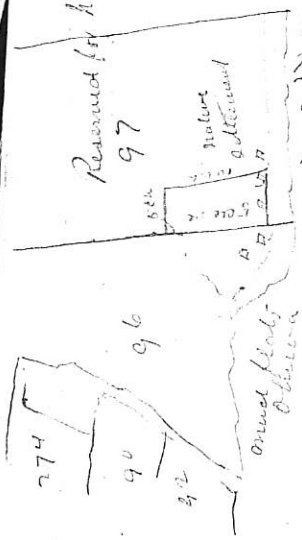

Sir

I take the liberty of informing you  
 that some time since I wrote to the Government  
 requesting them to grant 5 acres of land  
 to Te para Te Apirangi, to be cut out of  
 Section No 97 Parish of Waikato. I enclose  
 copies of letters from Government on the same  
 for your information. Upon receipt of the letter  
 giving permission to cultivate & marked off  
 on the date wished for 5 acres wanting for the  
 old station - but he now tells me that a  
 European has told him that he has bought  
 No 97 Parish of Waikato but which I think  
 is false as I believe it is reserved for future  
 purposes and also I have not seen it up  
 for sale - but should a request be  
 made to put it up for sale will you  
 kindly now stop it until you hear  
 from Government or Te para  
 to be cut out of it - the old station  
 had all his lands confiscated & now  
 it would now break his land & now  
 lose the 5 acres given  
 Government.
