Applications nos. 132 and 196 are by the accountant (J.H. Watson) for succession to Huhana Tutakangahau and Whitiara Hauaki, both deceased, in the above blocks, which is under Crown Purchase.

The above 2 interests are still unpurchased, owing to both these two persons, being dead. With a view to completing the purchase of the whole blocks, Head Office, has requested that applications for succession to these interests be lodged by me. (See correspondence attached to application 132.)

Head office has also asked that if possible only one successor should be appointed to each interest, owing to the small amount at credit for these interests. I have written Reid Kenana of Waimana to endeavour to have these interests succeeded to at the present sitting of the Court at Whakatane (15/10/34). He stated to me that he knew the successors to these two persons.

Previous orders in other blocks have been made to Huhana's interests (Whakatane MB 24/203. Name as Ripine Tutakangahau) but I am unable to find any succession orders having been made to Whitiara's interests, unless she is same as Whitiara Titoko (see Whakatane MB 15/24).

Will you please endeavour to have successors appointed at this court.
