REMISSION OF SURVEY CHARGES.

HIWARAU B30

1. Application has been made for the remission of interest on survey liens on the above-mentioned block of Maori Land.
2. The block contains **20 acres 3 roods 32 perches** and is situated in **Whakatane Survey District.**
3. There is a survey lien on the land amounting to **£ 8.1.2.**
4. Date of lien is **14.10.1920**
5. The total interest due at date of payment of survey lien was **£ 14.5.9.**
6. Interest for 5 years is **£ 2.0.5.**
7. Amount of interest for remission is **£ 12.5.4.**
8. The principal and five years' interest, a total of **£ 10.1.7.** was paid on **14.3.56**
9. It is recommended that the Minister approve the remission of interest beyond that required for 5 years under the provisions of Section 410 of the Maori Affairs Act, 1953.


