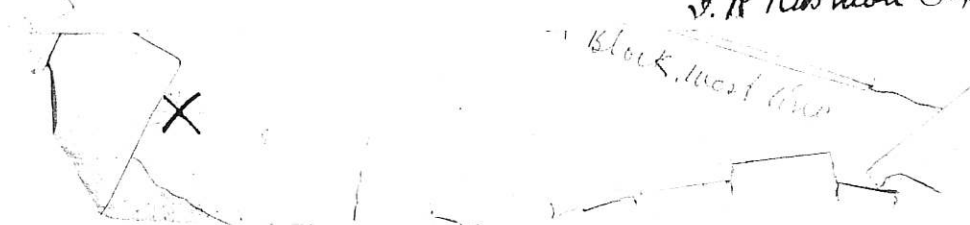

I have the honor to inform you that my wife a  
Maori (Name Maro Te Parai) is the owner of a small  
Section B. 16 1 A. about 10 acres, (In the Hiwarau B Block  
Containing 475 acres 46 Shares) Most of this Block has  
been Partitioned, with the exception of 40 acres, <sup>Papakarangi</sup> Hiwarau  
A. 785 Acres has been leased, Mr H. Reardon made the  
Survey of all Hiwarau Block, and Surveyed my wife's  
Section and adjoining ones, and never mentioned or  
showed any Road line through either my wife's or  
the adjoining sections Partitioned, the frontage to all  
on this side, <sup>the</sup> Coos Beach, I have heard that there  
is a Road line showing upon the Councils Letter  
graph Map, <sup>on the East side of No 13 Block</sup> which if so, I am sure is wrong -  
as not a mention is made of same by Mr Reardon  
when making the Partition Survey of the East side  
of Block; As a Maori who stole my wife's  
Fence Post, wants to force a Road line through  
her small Section, I take the liberty to ask you  
to forward me a <sup>Rough</sup> Drawing of the Survey made by  
Mr Reardon of B. 16 1 A. extending as far as the  
40 Acres <sup>Hiwarau A</sup> Papakarangi, four Sections to the West
