I am therefore sending you plan 7958 of the blook in case it may be useful if you have to make enquiries into the question of the areas of Houpoto Whitlare.

The area of Houpoto Whitiare id 731 acres and that of Tunapahore North No.1B is 1026ac.2r.00p.
