Application is hereby made to the Native Land Court to re-open the question of Succession to Repeka Tangikura in respect of her interest in Tahora No. 2^{AE} No. 2 Sec. 2 Block. The position is as follows:-

On the 1st. December, 1919, a Succession Order was made awarding the interest of the deceased to eight successors. On the 2nd June, 1920, another order was made in favour of Netana Whakaari. It is claimed that the first order was applicable only to the interest acquired by the deceased as part successor to Hemi Kakiu and that the original interest of the deceased was intended to be awarded to Netana as the person properly entitled. There does not appear to be much doubt on this point but it is necessary that the position should be cleared up as soon as possible as the Block is now under purchase by the Crown. Will you kindly therefore have the matter advertised for the first sitting of the Court in the District.
