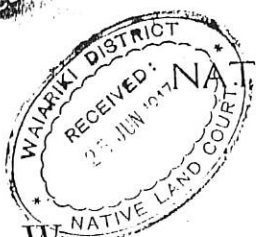

# NATIVE LAND ACT, 1909.

WHEREAS the sum specified with interest from 28/5/17

is claimed to be now due and owing to His Majesty the King by the Native

being the cost incurred by the Crown on behalf of the said Native owners in the survey of the said land, as appears by the certificate of the Chief Surveyor hereto annexed. Now, therefore, I hereby, on behalf of His Majesty, apply to the Native Land Court, under the provisions of the Native Land Act, 1909, for an order charging the said land with the payment to the Crown of the said sum of £ \_\_\_\_\_ by way of mortgage, with such additional sum by way of interest as to the Court shall seem fair and reasonable [or vesting in His Majesty a defined portion of the said land in fee-simple, in satisfaction and discharge of such cost of survey].
