WHEREAS the sum of £ 54 : 5 : 6 with interest from I/6/II is claimed to be now due

and owing to His Majesty the King by the Native owners of the land

known as ^{B C} Hiwarau Block

-No. B-

being the cost incurred by the Crown on behalf of the said Native owners

in the survey of the said land, as appears by the certificate of the ^{Chief} Surveyor-
General, hereto annexed. Now, therefore, I hereby, on behalf of His Majesty,

apply to the Native Land Court, under the provisions of "The Native Land

¹⁹⁰⁹ Court Act, 1894," for an order charging the said land with the payment to

the Crown of the said sum of £ 54 : 5 : 6 by way of mortgage,

with such additional sum by way of interest as to the Court shall seem fair

and reasonable [for vesting in His Majesty a defined portion of the said land

in fee simple, in satisfaction and discharge of such cost of survey].
