Block .

We send you application for injunction herein. The position is that Te Huinga Karauna, who is an owner in one subdivision of the Block, and Kohiti Horotiu the husband of another owner in the subdivision, has split about 1500 Totara posts and approximately 20,000 Rimu battens on the block. The applicants for the injunction are of the opinion that the posts and battens have been split on their subdivision, and as Te Huinga and Kohiti split on their subdivision, and as Te Huinga and Kohiti are about to sell the posts and battens, our clients desire them restrained from doing so until the boundary has been defined.

Our clients' attitude is that they would not mind Te Huinga and Kohiti making use of the posts and battens on the Tahora 2A 3B Block even not on our clients' subdivision, but they object to the posts and battens being sold for removal off the land.

For this reason we shall be glad if the Court can make ex parte and interim injunction. Our clients are taking steps to get a surveyor to define the boundary as soon as possible.
