WHEREAS the sum of £ 5 : 5 : is claimed to be now due and owing to Her Majesty the Queen by the Native owners of the land known as

Hiwarau containing 1260 acres situated in the

Opotiki District and numbered 100

Commissioner for Crown Lands

being the cost incurred by the Crown on behalf of the said Native owners in the survey of the said land, as appears by the certificate of the Surveyor General hereunto annexed. Now, therefore, I hereby, on behalf of Her Majesty, apply to the Native Land Court under the provisions of "The Native Land Court Act, 1894," for an order charging the said land with the payment to the Crown of the said sum of £ 5 : 5 : by way of mortgage, with such additional sum by way of interest as the Court shall seem fair and reasonable [or vesting in Her Majesty a defined portion of the said land in fee-simple, in satisfaction and discharge of such cost of survey].
