1 Paratene Te Aratahatu. I claim the whole of this block through Ancestry Conquest, and permanent occupation.

Apanui No.2 is the Ancestor I claim from. Panapa Te Nihotahi to be Kaiwhakahaere.

Panapa asked that case might be gone in to tomorrow morning. Court accordingly adjourned until 10 a.m. tomorrow.
