Your letter has reached me. It is well.
I am Makarita and I will be Trustee
with regard to the Hiwarau Block,
because I am Makarita was deposed by
the Court at Opotiki. This is a word of mine
to you about that man I am Makarita - let
him cease to have anything to do with Hiwarau,
for he spoke the truth when he told the Court
that he belonged to the Umuera. That is
all on that subject.

I will also speak the truth to you -
the land belongs to me, and the people belong
to me, they are of my hapu O Te Upokorohe.
Let the name of I am Makarita be taken
out of the Office.

Friend, you write my name wrongly,
it should be Kohere Tamakawerangi.
