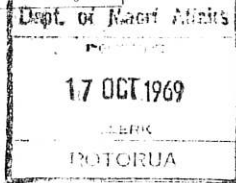


Dear Sirs,
