Now, therefore, I hereby, on behalf of His Majesty, apply to the Native Land Court, under the provisions of the Native Land Act, 1909, for an order charging the said land with the payment to the Crown of the said sum of £ _____ by way of mortgage, with such additional sum by way of interest as to the Court shall seem fair and reasonable [or vesting in His Majesty a defined portion of the said land in fee-simple, in satisfaction and discharge of such cost of survey].
