MAORI LAND COURT [L.S.] B. C. FREYBERG, Governor-General WALAND CAPPER A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act, 1928, I, Lieutenant General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General CP 1951 the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclain and declare that the additional land described in the Schedule height is herply taken for a Maori school; and I do also declare that this Proclamation RUA shall take effect on and after the 10th day of September, 1951 WA STRICT

... In the Gisborne Land District; as the same are more particularly delineated on the plan marked P.W.D. 133742, deposited in the office of the Minister of Works at Wellington, and thereon coloured as above mentioned.

The District Valuer's report is reproduced

below.

In the circumstances will you please ignore my memo.of 14.11.51 and the District Valuer's report and valuation dated 25.10.51.

"In 1949 when I inspected this lend I interviewed the Head Master of the Waioeka School to check the correct areas on the plan with the land that was to be taken. See my valuation of Waioeka 337B6A and pt. 337B6B dated 18.7.49.

In October, 1951 there was no one at the School and I obtained the help of a local resident who stated that the pt. 337B6B section was not the same parcel of land as the one previously walued in 1949 as that had already been incorporated in the School ground. From the sketch I was using it was practically impossible to site the correct area because of a creek which intersects the road and the road has been built off the correct line.

I looked into the position again on 1.5.52 and found the correct valuation is as stated on 18.7.49 and confirm the figures for pt. 337B6B as:

The valuation of 337B6A is: Imps. 20 ".
