TO ALL to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Know ye that, for good considerations Us thereunto moving, WE, for Us, our Heirs and Successors, do hereby Grant unto Teira Haruru, Hemi Kakita, Hemi Kuri, Taituha Oora, Kororapura, Koaroa, Ngipira, Hemi Hamu, Wahaika, Watene Pareata, Hoani Taone, Hauia Kapono, Great Takanaki, Kokore, Ahi, Tamati, Turui, Papai, Mohi Tauroa, oraka, Wiromu, Simeahua, Hoani Mokomoko, Warena, Akomoko, Maranara, Marau, Watene, Hene Katene, Siuromene, Tira, Oora, Aute, Hinewau, Kouraha, Ari Perai, Marau, Nu, Mere, Motuhore, Wheata, Kurukihou, Kipeka, Siopukori, Mahara, Hohi, Whakatane, Armerata, Rerakau, Maria, Grand Heni Hoxai, Huriwana, Peter, Henry, Ward, Kiripeti, Tomoti, Tawhiti, Kararana, Oliver, Ngakau, Raki, Ari, and Hinichou, His Heirs and Assigns, All that Parcel of Land in our Provincial District of Auckland in the

Colony of New Zealand, containing by admeasurement one thousand two hundred and sixty (160) acres more or less situated in the Whakatane Survey District and being Allotment number one hundred and eighty nine (189) of the Parish of Waiotahi Bounded towards the East by the Ohura Harbour by a road line the crossing of a road one hundred (100) links wide and a road line one thousand six hundred and seven (1607) links eight hundred and thirty one (831) links eight hundred and seventy (879) links six hundred and fifty four (654) links one thousand and forty-five (1045) links eight hundred and sixty eight (868) links seven hundred and sixteen (716) links two hundred and sixty eight (268) links three hundred and forty-five (345) links seven hundred and sixty-one (761) links two hundred and eighty (280) links four hundred and nineteen (419) links eight hundred and five (805) links one thousand two hundred and eighty-one (1281) links three hundred and forty (340) links six hundred and ten (610) links four hundred and eighty (480) links four hundred and seventy (470) links and three thousand two hundred and forty (3240) links towards the South and South West by the Tukuhou river and towards the North West by the Ohura Harbour aforesaid be all the aforesaid boundaries more or less save and excepting one surrounded space being allotments numbers two hundred and seventy five (275) and two hundred and seventy six (276) of the said parish in area fifty (50) acres as the same is delineated on the plan drawn in the margin hereof Also save and excepting a road one hundred (100) links wide and a road reserve which intersect the area hereby granted Subject nevertheless to the right of the Governor at any time hereafter to take and lay off for public purposes one or more line or lines of road in through or over the said parcel of land

As the same is delineated on the plan drawn in the margin hereof, WITH all the Rights and Appurtenances thereto belonging: To hold unto the said Tera Horuru, Hemi Kakitu, Hemi Kuri, Taikaha Paora, Horapapa, Horoal, Hobira, Hemi Hamu, Wohakaika, Walele, Pugreat, Hoani Meake, Iraiai Karponi, Nita Takarori, Kokere, Ari, Tamati, Turei, Apu, Mohi Taikoororakata, Wokana, Hinakura, Hoani, Mokomoko, Warena Mokomoko, Naraya, Maria Wakae, Ene Katene, Ationene, Tipa, Roa, Ruku, Hineraua Kopika, Ari Pika, Maria Tu, Hene Moutihore, Wheata, Burukera, Ripeka, Horopuku, Mahana, Mohi, Whakaekeu, Trinenda, Teal te Nara, Erana, Heli, Morai, Buruanua, Peke, Seni, Waru, Ripekoti, Timohi, Tauchi, Kararauna, Otuhi, Ngakai, Akuhi, Ari, and <sup>the</sup> his Heirs and Assigns for ever. Hinchow as from the 20<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1872.

Provided however that the said land hereby granted shall be unalienable by gift  
sale, lease or mortgage, or by lease for a longer period than fifteen years.


