Whiripare - and so Atauatōrauhi was the chief
of Heikitai and Sakekepare - the descendants
of Heikitai did not go back to Taiaroa
descended from the so Atauatōrauhi but Sakekepare
no right from that ancestor to these lands.

I will refer to the documents when speaking of Rewita's
case.

The descendants of Nakekai, Kawakawau and
Kauwhaki are now known as et. Ika and live now

at. Opihihi at Olara.
