Matahanea Store.

In 1906, when the usper haloe'd vlock was opened used and balloted for, there was a dray road only as far as Matah mea, then 15 miles from Opotiki, all stores and mail then going by packhorse to Oponae. Charles Pipe and a partner were for some time the contractors, Later contractors were Bill McLennan and about 1913 one of the Kellys, Jack, I think.

About 1907 or 1908 Bill Bickies started a store, and depot for mail and stores for the settlers, team team the packhorse could carry them on to Oponae. Beds were provided for weary travellers wish ing for a break before tackling the long journey to Oponae on horseback, the only useful pace on the narrow fascined track beingwhat became knowness the "Wioeka jog" 17 miles to Oponae.

About th 1913 the storekeeper wa. Andy Coward
