*Setting Apart Maori Freehold Land as a Maori Reservation*

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 15th day of  
November 1967

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT  
IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 439 of the Maori Affairs Act 1953, His  
Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by  
and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council,  
hereby sets apart the Maori freehold land described in the  
Schedule hereto as a Maori reservation, for the purpose  
of a burial ground for the common use and benefit of the  
Whakatohea tribe and the Maoris of the area.

District, and described as follows:
