Just a line by Delaney to say  
Aira Le Popo with 30 of his people came  
in this morn<sup>g</sup>. I have put them in the  
Park & done all main told me to regarding  
them, no news out of them yet, must let them

out of them - no other native news -  
This Chief has been out ever since Volkner's  
murder - Kelly's storekeeper has an account  
against him for forage for the month of  
May for this place, so he tells me
