TWIN ROCKS KAHIKATEA

Karihi Potae	-(Rongopopia and men killed here by Tuamutu)
Te Ahi aua	-Pipi bed
Korokoro	-(stream) the bridge going up to Ohiwa
Tarewarewa	-a stream
Waikereao	-Turn off to Gabriels Gully
Te Keke	-Opposite old red cowshed on Jensen farm
Te Ika Whakaata	-Road going to Raiketes old place
Upokonui	-The hill on the opposite side
Pukenui-o-raoraho	-Trig station
Moteko	-Rawis Place (Pines)
Maromahue	-Marae
Te Ruawheru	-Left handside Reo's Farm
Mata Kohitia	-opposite cemetery
Noho Rangi	-Urupa
Puhangahau	-McCormacks
Te matau a maui	-Flat on the right before toones bridge
Kaituri	-bridge (where old crossing was)
Papatotara	-across the road from Manny's drive
Kopuaroa	-Narena Randell
Huruhuru	-Just around the bend
Te Mapara	-approx Kent Watsons
Te Waiwhero	-Len Helmbrights old place
Whakataua	-Te Huinga Karauna's farm
