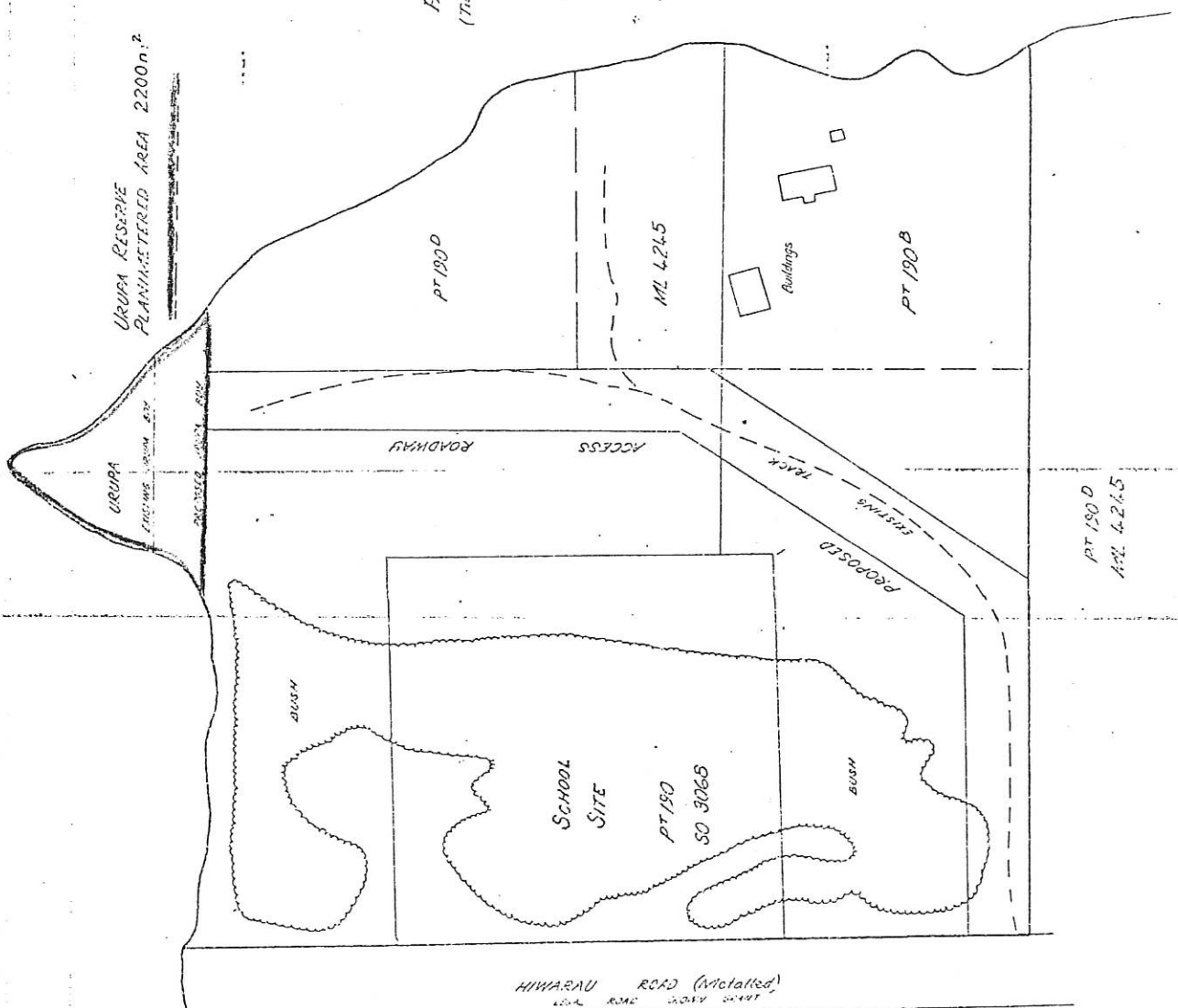

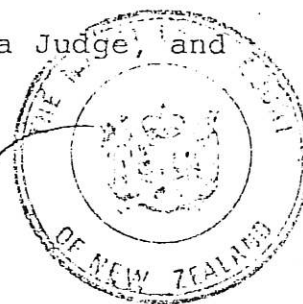
AT a sitting of the court held at Rotorua on the 23rd day

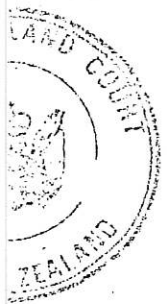

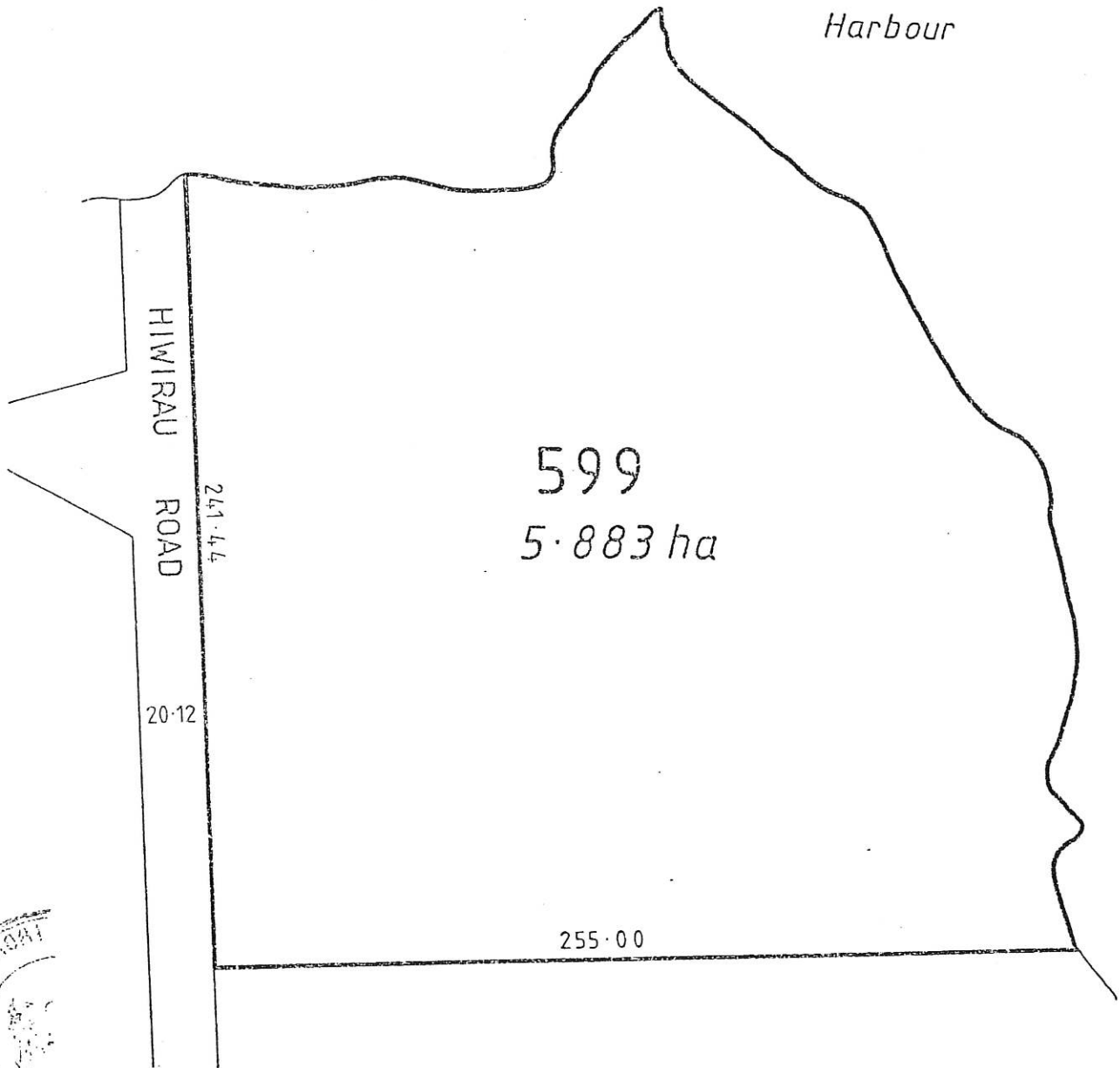

Setting Apart Maori Freehold Land as a Maori Reservation

PURSUANT to section 439 of the Maori Affairs Act 1953, the Maori freehold land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby set apart as a Maori reservation for the purpose of a marae for the common use and benefit of the Upokorehe Hapu of Whakatohea to be known as Roimata Marae.
